This Graduate Diploma course provides students with the skills for critical engagement in spiritual care and pastoral contexts. Students will engage secular practices and Christian traditions of care to develop relevant, flexible strategies for effective pastoral mission and practices of care.

Graduates of this course:

- ✓ **Have knowledge of sources, terms and concepts** required for theological engagement of care practices
- ✓ **Apply their own experience and practice** to social, cultural and behavioural studies and offer an integration of these with the Christian tradition
- ✓ **Have skills to explore issues** of Christian identity, personal vocation and self-awareness in care contexts
- ✓ **Apply advanced pastoral helping skills** with an ability to engage care practices with a theological lens

- Do you desire to deepen your understanding of spiritual and pastoral care practices so as to better serve others in your professional and ministry settings?

Pastoral Care Program

The Pastoral Program is made up of 4 standard postgraduate units and 2 Supervised Theological Field Educations (STFE) units. The STFE units allow students to integrate their key learnings in a practical Pastoral Care setting, with guidance and supervision.

Spiritual Care Program

The Spiritual Care Program is made up of 4 standard postgraduate units and 2 practical units in a clinical pastoral setting. Students will apply their key learnings with supervision and support.

Course Structure

The Graduate Diploma in Pastoral and Spiritual Care is offered in two programs.

The pastoral care program is aimed at supporting those in church and Christian faith-based settings who require integrated knowledge and advanced skills in pastoral care practice.

The spiritual care program is aimed at supporting carers and practitioners involved in multifaith clinical settings providing advanced knowledge and practice in spiritual care as well as supervised clinical experience in spiritual care.
